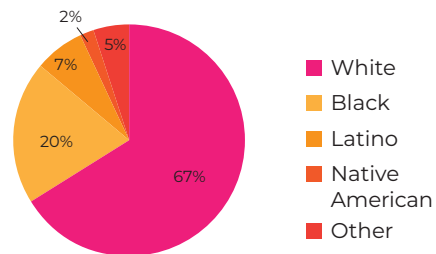
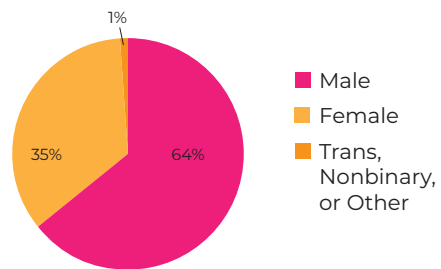

MADONNA HOUSE

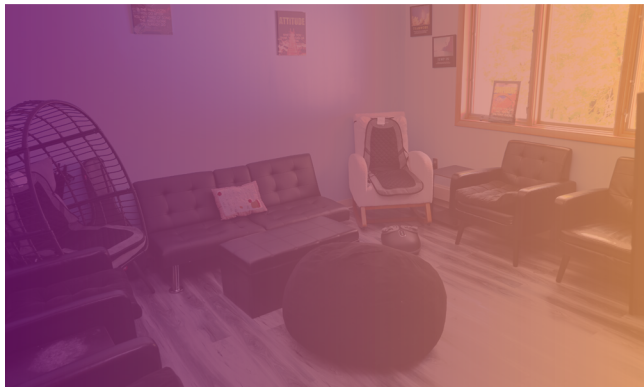


Above: the new Madonna House extension

Throughout 2025, Caz Recovery expanded Madonna House so that we can support even more women and their children.

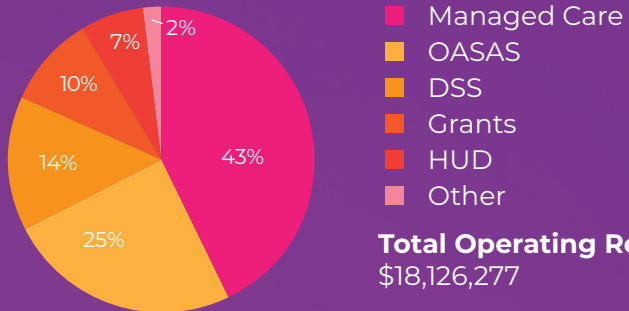
After years of planning, we added an extension onto the front of the building that increased the program's total bed count from 16 to 21.

In addition, the new extension contains dedicated rooms for groups and therapy sessions, private offices for counselors, a new kitchen, and an elevator. The newly-renovated space also contains a daycare center, a gym, upgraded bathrooms, and redesigned storage and kitchen areas.



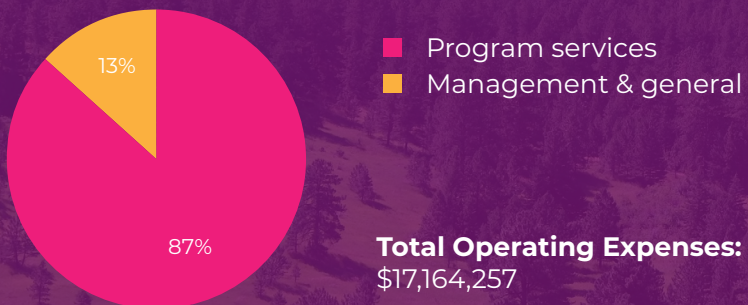
FINANCES
